Are you aware?

Are you aware that 3,287 people are sold or kidnapped and forced into slavery every day? Not many people are. That's 136 an hour and that's just the reported cases. Are you aware that most of these are children and most of them are sold repeatedly for sex? Again, it's a little known fact but it's real and it's happening all around us -- even here in the US.

Trafficking in women and children for sexual exploitation is one of the most serious human rights violations in todays world.

Protecting children from violence, exploitation and abuse is an integrate component of protecting their freedom to survive, grow & develop.

Are you aware that the global sex slavery market generates \$32 billion in profits each year? I bet it will astonish you that the only crime to outpace it is illegal drugs. This is amazing as the average human is sold into slavery for less than \$100.

Are you aware that UNICEF has written that at any time there are 2 million children being trafficked in the global sex trade? (as reported by the U.S. Census Bureau in 2010).

Trafficking in children is a global problem affecting large numbers of children. There is a

demand for trafficked children as cheap labour or for sexual exploitation. Children and their families are often unaware of the dangers of trafficking, believing that better employment and lives lie in other countries.

Are you aware that 300,000 American children are at risk of child sexual exploitation and about 55% of the girls living on the streets are engaged in sexual slavery? They can start as a troubled youth or as a valedictorian -- the crime of trafficking is about opportunity, not about the child.
